What **bodies** are there, who are the **members**, what **competencies** and **decisions** can they make, what is the **relationship** with the other bodies

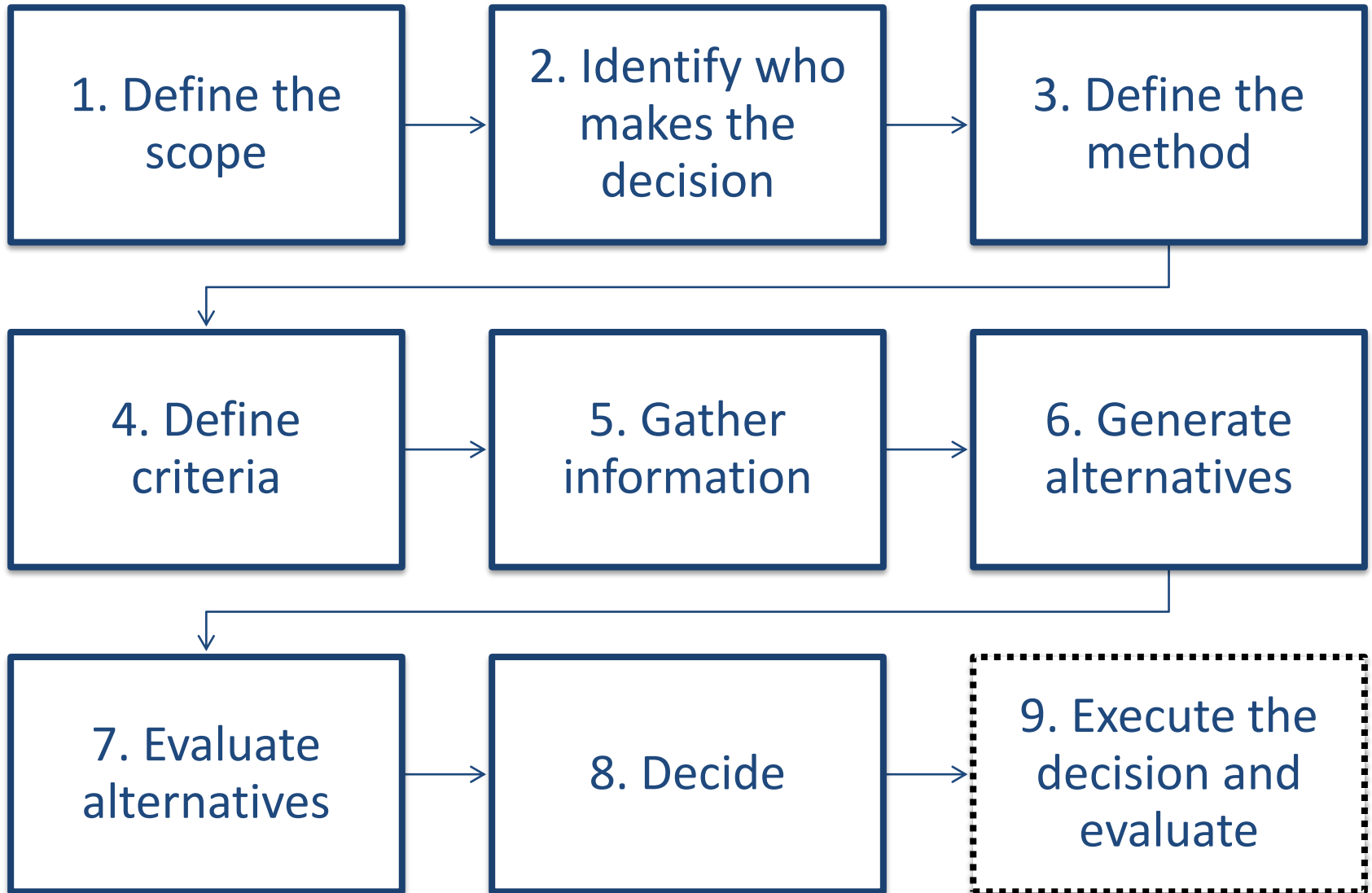
A governance system has ...

1. Decisions ...
2. Functions, competences and tasks
3. Information and transparency mechanisms
4. Accountability
5. Disagreement management mechanisms
6. Decision recording mechanisms
7. Participation and membership structures (horizontal and multisectoral interrelation)

- Organizational or Tactical
- Operational

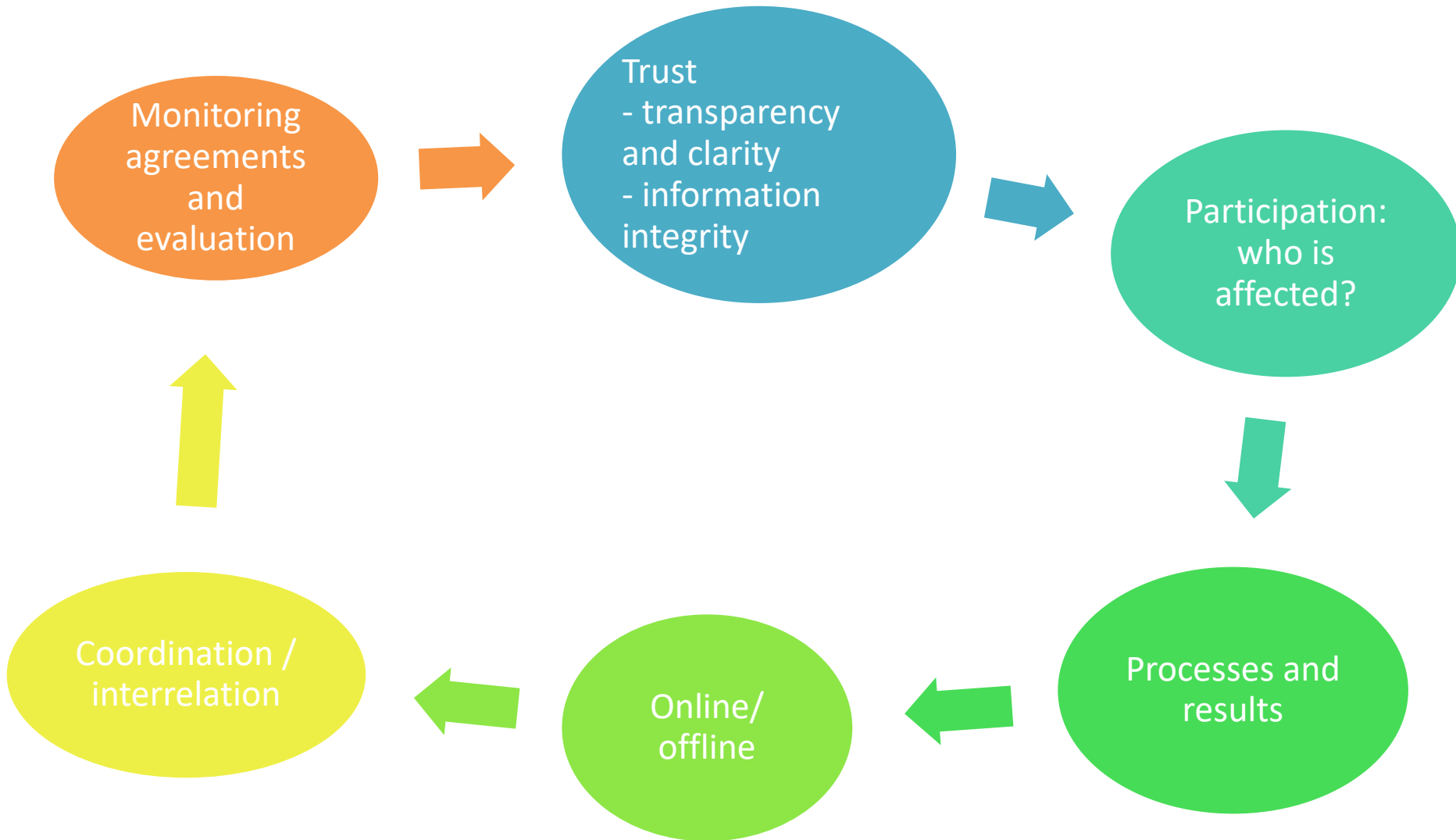
Decision making processes
